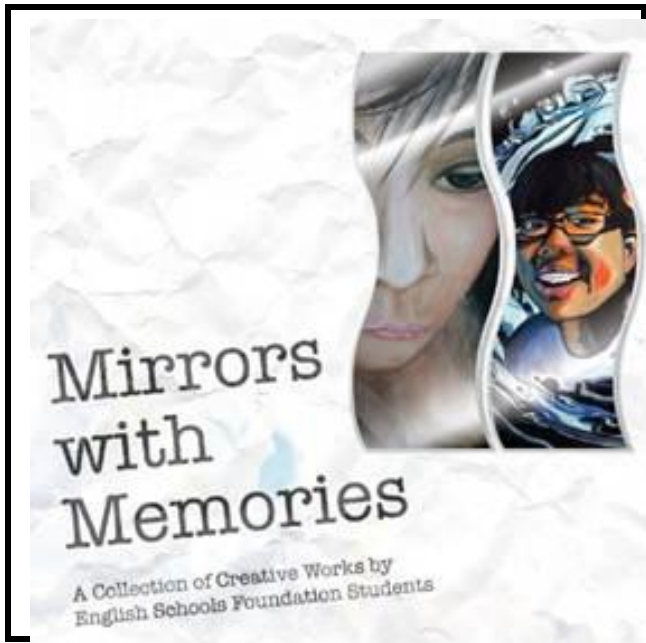


ESF Book Launch, "Mirrors with Memories" by John Doherty and David Hooper
